One location near the totem pole might be the best because it is visible yet unaffected by events happening on the other side of the footpath. A Seattle architect has been hired to work on the proposal. The City still needs to decide if they want to change the comp plan to include the change in the playground location. • Waterfront Redevelopment – Public notice of the walkway between the end of Cornwall Ave and Boulevard has been sent out, although hearings have not begun yet.
