**MNAC:** There was not an MNAC meeting in August. Howard did report that MNAC had sent a letter to the mayor in June expressing opposition to the Gateway Pacific Terminal project, and in July MNAC sent that same letter to the agency performing the EIS (likely Whatcom County/Department of Ecology?). Discussion about whether the neighborhood itself should also write a letter. A committee was formed to address this issue: Mike Kimmich, Rae Edwards, and Earl Hutchins.

**Treasurer:** Vince Brown reported there is \$2226 in the treasury.

**Motion:** Donate \$20 to the church each month for allowing LSNA to use their meeting space.

**Outreach:** Fall newsletter – articles due by October 14. Include new neighborhood businesses – Johnny's Donuts and Sound Imaging.

**Other:** Street Trees – the middle school did their own landscaping, so is out for the project. Shannon Neufeld made an official donation. The plan is to identify sites and plant in November. Since they will go on city property, they might be able to purchase through the parks department with a discount and transported up to Bellingham.
